The Bidar fort is considered to have been built in Persian Architectural style during the reign of the Western Chalukya dynasty.



Jodhpur - Jaisalmer 29 Jan – 03 February 2024






Gwalior – Jhansi – Orchha - Khajuraho 25 Feb – 2 March 2024
